CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. For this Challenge we require a registration fee of £250 (non-refundable), which should be enclosed with your application form (made payable to Classic Tours).
2. You will pay the registration fee of £250 yourself and commit to raising a minimum sponsorship of £2500 in aid of Dentaid. This way Dentaid retains over 50% of the money you raise while the rest will go to pay the balance of your tour cost. We will invoice Dentaid, 8 weeks prior to departure, for the tour cost minus the registration fee. We will invoice you for the airport tax 8 weeks prior to departure. You will pay all your sponsorship money to Dentaid, not Classic Tours. Dentaid will need to receive 100% of your minimum sponsorship by 3rd August 2009, 10 weeks before departure. Until Dentaid receives 100% of the sponsorship and Classic Tours has received your airport tax your place on the challenge is not confirmed.
3. The tour cost is based on a minimum of 30 people taking part. If the number falls below this level the tour cost may increase.
4. You MUST notify Dentaid that you will be participating in this challenge and raising funds in their name. They may require you to sign their terms and conditions.
5. Upon receipt of your registration form we will seek written confirmation from Dentaid that you have contacted them, that they have authorised you to raise funds in their name, and that they will be invoiced for the balance of your tour costs. Once we have received this from Dentaid we will confirm your successful registration.
6. All funds raised in connection to this challenge should be paid directly to Dentaid.
7. When fundraising you MUST make clear to donors what proportion of funds raised are going to the charity and how much towards costs.
8. Should you, for whatever reason, cancel your place on the challenge, the cancellation terms are set out in the Classic Tours booking conditions.
9. If you withdraw in circumstances where recovery of cancellation charges is indemnified under your travel insurance, you hereby agree that you will co-operate in the recovery of these charges from the insurers and any sums recovered under the policy will be paid to the charity.
10. Should you have to withdraw, all sponsor forms and monies should be forwarded to Dentaid or returned to the sponsor.
11. If you are unable to meet the sponsorship money requirements, you will forfeit your place. However, you may choose to make up the balance yourself.
12. Except as stated in the booking conditions, the registration fee is non-refundable.
13. You must be at least 18 years old before the departure date of the event.
14. You must not suffer from alcohol or drug dependency or have any criminal convictions.
15. Classic Tours specialises in challenges of this nature and is fully bonded by the Civil Aviation Authority, ATOL 3379 and Travel Organisers Failure Travel (TOFC). Classic Tours is unable to accept liability for any loss or damage; however arising, or for the cancellation of the event for any reasons outside their control.

16. Itineraries, schedules and accommodation may change and other alterations may occur which are beyond the control of Classic Tours.
17. Your passport must have at least six months to run from the date you return to the UK.
18. You must wear a cycle helmet at ALL times when cycling.
19. You participate at your own risk. If you are refused passage and/or entry/exit to or from the country that you are visiting, any additional costs incurred are your responsibility.
20. You must have adequate travel insurance that will cover you for the specific activities you will be undertaking, including medical expenses and emergency repatriation. You will be asked to provide proof of travel insurance 8 weeks prior to the event, or you may forfeit your place on the challenge.
21. Classic Tours may, at their sole discretion, withdraw places on the Great Wall of China trek if it is believed to be in their best interest to do so.
